# **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

between

the Institute for Geological and Geochemical Research, RCAES, Hungary

the Innsbruck Quaternary Research Group, Institute of Geology, University of Innsbruck, Austria

### Article 1.

The Institut e for Geological and Geochemical Research, Hungary, and the Innsbruck Quaternary Research Group, Institute of Geology, University of Innsbruck, Austria hereinafter referred as Sides, having common scientific interests; agree herein to cooperate in scientific research.

#### Article 2.

The objectives of the cooperation are:

- establishment of a joint research working group called Nanomineralogy of Cave Deposits (NANOCAVE);
- joint publications in leading international journals;
- joint research projects both bilateral between the sides' countries and potential international projects;

### Article 3.

## The Sides agree:

- to use laboratory facilities for joint research;
- to conduct in-site cave research and sampling with the leadership of the Innsbruck research group;
- to allow exchange of resources required for field and laboratory investigations according to supplemental mutual agreements drown in compliance with legislations compulsory to the Sides;
- to assist the exchange of the staff of the Sides in form of visits on the basis of individual invitations.

## Article 4.

The Agreement comes into force on the date of signature and is valid for a period of five years. After this first year it will be automatically extended for an indefinite period, unless one of the parties expresses an intention to cancel the agreement three months before the expiry date.

The Agreement is signed in duplicate.
